Important Notes for Submission

- 1. There are three deadlines for submission. The first and second will be on June 1st 18:00. The last deadline will be on July 2nd 18:00. Please note that your submission will be completed when you have filled out all required fields and make yout payment for the application.
- 2. Write down the exact name of the department you applied for in Korean or English. You cannot change the department you applied or receive refund for application fee once you completed your submission.
- 3. All documents must be in Korean or English. Any documents written in languages other than those two languages must be translated into Korean or English.
- 4. Please print out the test ID slip. The test ID slip is required for checking your interview schedule, exam/interview results and tuition fee payment.
- 5. Even if you have finished online registration, you will be excluded from document screening if you don't submit necessary documents within the deadline.
- 6. CBNU is not responsible for any disadvantages resulting from writing down invalid contact point or being out of contact.
- 7. CBNU will only accept official language exam certificates that was issued within the last two years.

Important Notes for All Applicants

- 1. All required documents must be original documents. If originals cannot be submitted, copies can be submitted only if they have been confirmed as true copies of the original by relevant organizations/institutions or the Office of International Cooperation at Chonbuk National University upon submission.
- 2. All the submitted documents and application fee will not be returned or refunded after finishing application period, and changing your department is not allowed once the application has been accepted. (The original Certificate of Graduation will be returned after all entrance procedures are completed.)
- 3. All the information including admission announcements will be posted on the homepage so applicant must follow the directions carefully.
- 4. CBNU is not responsible for any disadvantages resulting from not submitting necessary documents submitting invalid contact points, not following application process, not confirming the final application results, being out of contact and etc.
- 5. Evaluation scores for admission will not be disclosed.
- 6. If any of application documents contain false information or forgery, admission will be cancelled immediately. Also, if an applicant is found to be not fully eligible for the requirement, admission may also be rescinded even after the admission has been granted. In this case, tuition fee is non-refundable. Furthermore, they cannot apply for CBNU for next 3 years.
- 7. Applicant who is enrolled in two or more universities on the same semester or fail to pay their tuition fee before the designated deadline may be Denied or Disqualified for Admission
- 8. Admitted applicant who is an expected graduate or still attending school/university/college at the time of the application submission must submit a Certificate of Completion or Diploma to the OIC, CBNU by Aug 24th(Fri), 2018, otherwise their admission may be withdrawn.
- 9. Regulations of CBNU are applied to the items that are not defined on this prospectus and other particulars are decided by the Committee of Admission Screening for International Students.
- 10. Final successful candidates must read through 'Notes', and must apply for their visa, dormitory, insurance and sign up for lectures within the given period. Also, they must pay the tuition fee during the given period
- * This admission guideline is originally written in Korean and translated into English and Chinese. Should there be any discrepancies, Korean version dominates translated versions.

 - * Students will be placed to their pre-assigned departments after the end of the first year. Students can change their pre-assigned majors during their first year or at the end of the year through following due procedures.
 - * Students who applied to college of arts and English Track will be placed to their majors upon entering.

Eligibility and Requirements

* There's no limit for the number of applicants. However, each department will go through internal evaluation on capability to accept international students.

A. Citizenship/Academic Requirements

- 1) Freshman (first year) student: Applicant must meet one of the following requirements
 - A) Applicants and his/her parents must be foreign nationals, must not possess Korean citizenship and must have completed or expected to complete regular curriculums at accredited primary and secondary educational institutions in Korea or overseas (Dual citizenship holders cannot to apply) (Students who have passed Qualification for High School Graduation are eligible to apply)
 - B) Applicant who have foreign passports and have completed curriculums in overseas that are equivalent to primary and secondary education in Korea.
- 2) Transfer Student: Applicant must meet a) and b) [or] a) and c)
 - A) Applicants and his/her parents must be foreign nationals and must not possess Korean citizenship [or] Applicants must be foreign nationals and must have completed regular primary and secondary education overseas
 - B) Applicants must have completed or be expected to complete at least 2 years of a 4-year undergraduate degree program- with acquisition of 65 credits(35 credits if applicants want to apply as sophomore) for graduation- at an accredited university inside or outside Korea
 - c) Applicants must have graduated or be expected to graduate from a 2- to 3-year associate degree program at an accredited college inside or outside of Korea with acquisition of 65 credits
 - Expected graduates from junior college can apply
 - *Graduates from non-accredited university cannot apply
 - * Applicants can apply regardless of majors from their previous university, and recognition for course credits will be up to the dean's decision from each department
 - * Applicants who were expelled from school for disciplinary actions and students currently enrolled to CBNU, including CBNU students on gap years cannot apply

- B. Language Proficiency Requirements: Applicants who meet one of the following requirements
 - 1) General (International Natural Science, International Humanity Studies, College of Arts and transfer students)
 - A) Applicant with Test of Proficiency in Korean TOPIK Level 3 or above.
 - B) Applicant who has completed **Korean Class Level 4** at the Korean Language Education Center in Korea.
 - C) Applicant for the College of Arts(except for Industrial Design) may apply without the above mentioned language proficiency if they can take classes that are delivered in Korean.
- 2) English Track (Jimmy Carter School of International Studies and Engineering Science)
 - A) Engineering Science: Applicants must have one of the following Official English scores TEPS 600(New TEPS 330), IELTS 5.5, iBT TOEFL 71 (CBT 197, PBT 530)
 - B) Jimmy Carter School of International Studies: Applicants must have one of the following Official English scores TEPS 600(New TEPS 330), IELTS 5.5, iBT TOEFL 80
 - C) For all applicants to English Track: Applicants from English speaking countries can substitute official English test scores with their certificates of middle and high school graduation
 - * English speaking countries include the USA, the UK, Canada, Australia, New zealand, Republic of South Africa, Ireland, the Philippines and India

Application Procedure / Paying application fee

A. How to Apply

- 1) Online Application: Submit application form on UWAYAPPLY(http://www.uwayapply.com)
- 2) Mail Application: Print and submit a completed set of required documents to the designated address of CBNU before the application deadline
 - * After the online application deadline, the modification of application detail as well as cancellation of application are not permitted

B. Admission Criteria: Document Screening and Interview

- 1) Document screening: Office of International Cooperation will examine whether applicants have submitted all necessary documents and have appropriate language proficiency
- 2) Interview: Each department and Office of International Cooperation will conduct interview (Students living abroad will be interviewed on the phone)

- 2) If students want to withdraw their dormitory application, they have to inform to either the Office of International Cooperation or the Office of the Dormitory by 24th Aug. You will be charged for the dormitory fee if you cancel the application after semester begins.
