

Residence Hall Fee Payment Guide

The International Affairs Office will submit the Residence Hall Application to the dormitory administration office for the students who submitted the dormitory application with the 2009 Spring Semester application.

Please check the dormitory application results on the website, print out the fee statement and pay the fee to the designated bank.

Failure to make payments during the designated period will result in the automatic cancellation.

- ☐ Fee Payment Period: February 3 ~ 5, 2009

- ☐ Entrance Qualifications
 - University students who are able to live in a group environment and are physically and mentally healthy
 - Qualified persons through the regulations of the Residence Hall (see Residence Hall Homepage: 생활안내 --> 생활수칙 --> 생활관규정 for reference)
 - Students who agree with the following conditions
 - * Black points will be given if arriving to the dormitory after curfew of 23:50 to 04:30.
 - * Smoking and Alcohol are prohibited inside the building. Please refrain from making loud noises as it may disturb others.
 - * Students who live in the dormitory must eat at the cafeteria.
[Hyemin Hall residents must take care of their meals individually and may buy meal tickets at the Medical School cafeteria.]
 - * Students must follow the tenant rules. (see Residence Hall Homepage: 생활안내 --> 생활수칙 --> 생활관생수칙 for reference.)
- ☐ International students will be assigned the new BTL dormitory and must eat meals at the dormitory cafeteria. There are no meal services on the weekends (Saturday & Sunday), so you have to take care of meals on your own.

☐ BTL Residence Hall (Hyemin Hall, Chambit Hall) Facilities

- Room: desk, chair, wardrobe, shoe rack, bookshelf, internet, shower stall, lavatory
- Common Room: lounge, seminar room, reading room, computer room, training room, AV room
- Attached Facilities: laundry room (coin operated), dining hall, convenience store (CVS), stationery store, cafe, etc.
- Telephone Service: 2,200 Won (a month/ user individual charge)

☐ Fee

- Opening Period for Spring Semester, 2009: March 2 ~ June 17, 2009 (108 days)
- Chambit Hall (in the Residence Hall) - 2 persons/room: 837,060 Won (meals included except for on Saturdays and Sundays)
 - ※ 3 meals a day except Saturdays and Sundays
- Hyemin Hall (in the Medical School) - 2 persons/room: 396,360 Won (meals not included)
 - ※ There are no meal services for Hyemin Hall residents. Students may use the Medical School cafeteria.
 - ※ Fees are subject to change according to the university academic calendar.
