## 1. Eligibility for Application

A. Foreign Language Exam (Exam for English or Major-related English) or the Second Foreign Language Exam

1) Master course students
a. Students currently enrolled

- Qualification: Completion of more than 12 major credits at the end of 2016 Fall semester
(Excluding prerequisite subject or previous credits)
b. Students who completed the course : no limitation of credits
※ Students must take the exam again if 6 years have passed from the date of course completion
※ Students on a leave of absence are not eligible, but if they are expected to return in the Spring semester 2017, they may contact the corresponding College for the application

2) Doctor course students (only 4 departments should take the Second Foreign Language Exam, refer to the appendix)
a. Students currently enrolled

- Qualification: Completion of more than 12 major credits at the end of 2016 Fall semester
(Excluding prerequisite subject or previous credits)
b. Students who completed the course : no limitation of credits
※ Students must take the exam again if 8 years have passed from the date of course completion
※ Students on a leave of absence are not eligible, but if they are expected to return in the Spring semester 2017, they may contact the corresponding College for the application
B. Comprehensive Exam

1) Master Course
a. Students currently enrolled

- Qualification: Completion of more than 24 total credits at the end of 2016 Fall semester
[Major Course(24 credits) + Prerequisites $=$ Total Credits for the completion]
b. Students who completed the course : there is no limitation of Credits
※ Students must take the exam again if 6 years have passed from the date of course completion
※ Students on a leave of absence are not eligible, but if they are expected to return in the Spring semester 2017, they may contact the corresponding College for the application

2) Doctor Course
a. Students currently enrolled

- Qualification: Completion of more than 36 total credits at the end of 2016 Fall semester
[Major Course(36 credits) + Prerequisites $=$ Total Credits for the completion]
b. Students who completed the course : there is no limitation of Credits
※ Students must take the exam again if 8 years have passed from the date of course completion
※ Students on a leave of absence are not eligible, but if they are expected to return in the Spring semester 2017, they may contact the corresponding College for the application
C. Nullity
- The qualification will be invalidated even if the student passed the exam in case the student turned out to be an ineligible student for the exam (Check the qualification carefully).

A. Foreign Language Exam (English or Major-related English) or the Second Foreign Language Exam

1) Master Course : English or Major-related English
2) Doctor Course : English or Major-related English or the Second Foreign Language
B. Comprehensive Exam
3) Master Course : 4 Major subjects
4) Doctor Course : 6 Major subjects

## 3.Pass criterion

A. Foreign Language Exam (English or Major-related English) or the Second Foreign Language Exam

1) Master Course: 60+ out of 100 points
(If your major is English Language and Literature, It is 70+ out of 100 points)
2) Doctor Course: 70+ out of 100 points
(If your major is English Language and Literature, It is 80+ out of 100 points)
B. Comprehensive Exam
3) Master Course: 140+ out of 200 points
4) Doctor Course: 210+ out of 300 points
※ There is no subject failure, just need to achieve overall score of $70 \%+$

1) Students currently enrolled

Go to CBNU Portal $\Rightarrow$ Enter your personal data (ID: Student No., Password) and Login $\Rightarrow$ Graduation Management $\Rightarrow$ Application for foreign language exam and comprehensive exam 〔foreign language (English or Major-related English), (Second foreign language if relevant) and Major exam $\Rightarrow$ Tick the exam subjects you are taking $\Rightarrow$ Click the exam application $\Rightarrow$ Logout
2) Students who completed the course
3) Go to CBNU Portal $\Rightarrow$ Enter your personal data (ID: Student No., Password) and Login $\Rightarrow$ Graduation Management $\Rightarrow$ Application for foreign language exam and comprehensive exam 〔foreign language (English or Major-related English), (Second foreign language if relevant) and Major exam $\Rightarrow$ Tick the exam subjects you are taking $\Rightarrow$ Click the exam application $\Rightarrow$ Logout
4) Check the examinees' number: Feb. $13^{\text {th }}$ (Mon) to Feb. $23^{\text {rd }}$ (Thu)
B. Documents needed for the students who can be exempted from the Foreign Language Exam

1) Submission Period : Jan. $31^{\text {st }}$ (Tue) to Feb. $3^{\text {rd }}$ (Fri)
2) Where to submit : Registrar \& Class Management Office Annex to Headquarters (Bldg no.1-2) $2^{\text {nd }}$ Floor
3) Document: Both a hard copy and a scan copy
4) How to submit : Write the name of course, student ID No. and your full name on the document
5) Students who have submitted the documents for exemption are not allowed to apply for the Foreign Language Exam through OASIS

※ Exam candidates for English or Major-related English (identical for Master's and Doctor's) must take the selected subject exam, otherwise; the result will be not recognized and resulted in cancelation. (if your department is not shown above or not written correctly, please immediately contact the corresponding department)

## Instructions for Foreign Language Exam takers

1. Foreign Language Exam takers must enter the exam room 30 minutes before the test. (English and second foreign language exam takers must sit in the assigned seat)
2. Exam takers must use the below materials for writing.
A. Multiple Choice Questions for English Exam (OMR Card): Exam takers must use aqueous pen for computer use to fill in the OMR Card. If not, the answers will not be recognized and exam takers take the whole responsibility.
※Aqueous pen for computer use must be prepared by the exam takers
B. Essay type questions for English Exam or Second Foreign Language Exam: Exam takers must use black, blue or navy color pen. Usage of either pencil or other color pens will be resulted in 0 points.
3. Exam takers must firstly fill in their examinees' number and name on the top of the answer sheet when supervisor release the examination and answer paper.
4. With regard to essay type questions for English Exam and Second Foreign Language Exam, exam takers need to answer total 2 questions; choose one question from $A$ and $B$, and one question from $C$ and $D$. In case the exam taker choose both $A$ and $B$ or both $C$ and D for his or her answer, then only one answer with the higher mark will be counted.
5. How to fill in the essay type questions for English Exam and Second Foreign Language Exam

- You must answer two questions into a two separate paper (one question for one paper). You should not write down at the back of the paper, which will be invalid.
- Please fill in your student number, name and question number on every single answer sheet.

6. Exam takers must return all examination and answer paper to the supervisor when the test is over.
7. Exam takers must show their identification card (student card, driver's license or
identity card).
※Without identification card, exam takers are not allowed to take the exam.
8. Second Foreign Language Exam takers may bring and refer to corresponding subject's dictionary.
9. English (Major-related English) exam takers are not allowed to use dictionary.
※ Exam takers are not allowed to scribble or write down anything unnecessary other than an answer. It will be resulted in 0 points.
※ Exam takers have benefit of free parking (show your test identification slip when you are leaving the parking lot.
