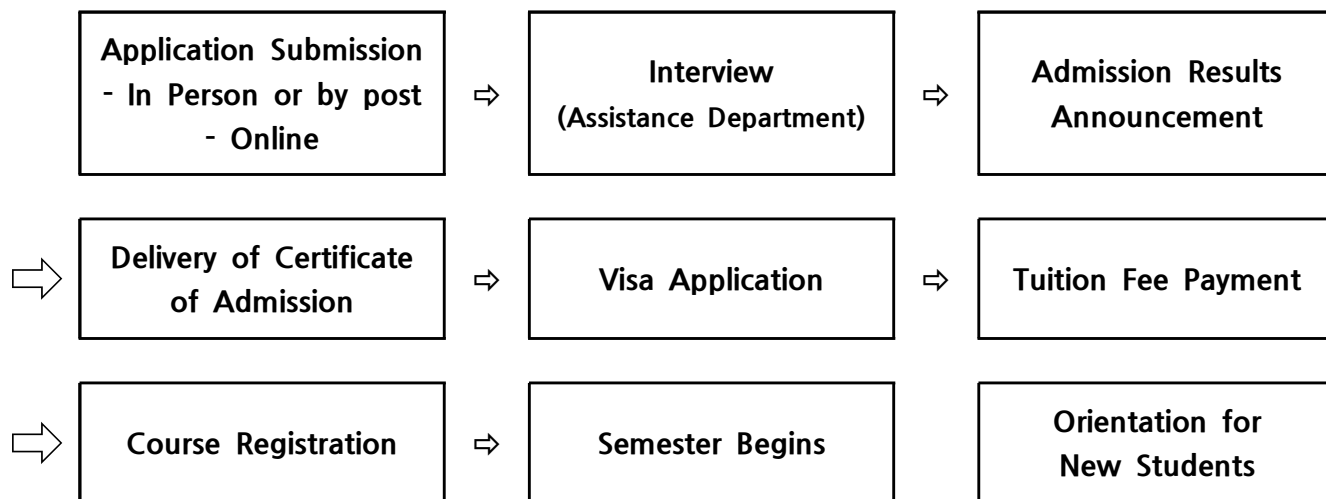

# Eligibility for Application

### A. Nationality and Education background

- 1) **A foreigner whose parents are also foreigners.**
  - International students with foreign citizenship whose parents both have foreign citizenship or those who have graduated or are expected to graduate from a Korean or foreign high school.
  - ※ Holders of dual citizenship -one of which is Korean citizenship- can NOT apply as an International student.
- 2) **A foreigner who have completed elementary school, middle school and high school course outside Korea.** (Nationality of the applicant's parents does not matter.)

### B. Language Proficiency

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>All (Except for Jimmy Carter School of International Studies)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Applicants with TOPIK Grade 3 or above OR</li> <li>- Applicants who have completed Level 4 Korean class at the Korean Language Education Center in Chonbuk National University or other universities in Korea OR</li> <li>- Applicants who have passed the test which acknowledged from Korean Language Education Center in Chonbuk National University.</li> <li>- The applicants for the College of Arts (except for Industrial Design) may apply without the above mentioned language proficiency certifications if they are capable of "taking classes in Korean."</li> <li>※ It is valid only if the student passed the application recognition score.</li> <li>※ If registered to take the TOPIK exam in July, applicants must submit their TOPIK Identification or Examination Number. After that, the applicants must submit their TOPIK Test Result until Aug. 5th, 2016. 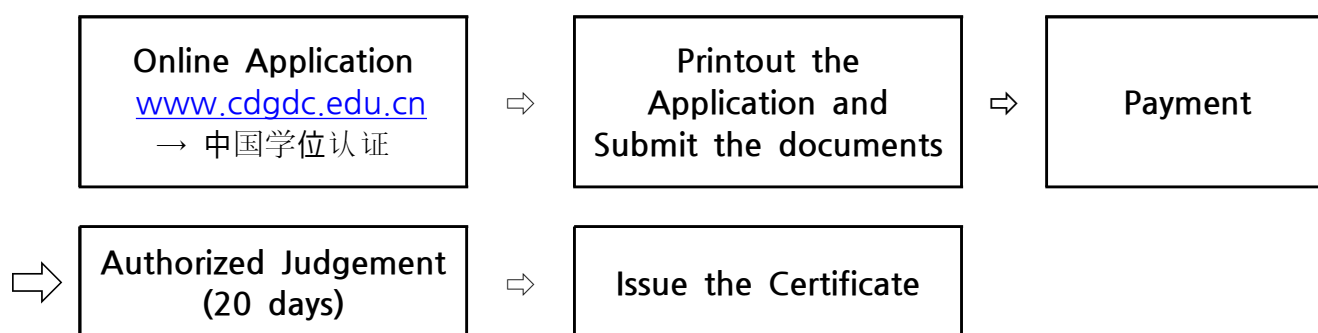

- ※ If an issue of the verification form is not yet complete at the time of applying, applicants must submit copies of transcript/diploma and proof of application along with other required documents. Applicants must submit the original transcripts/diplomas and verification form (approved by the above institutions only) by **Aug.19th, 2016**. Failure to do so will cause your admission cancelled.

**\* Submission of Additional Documents: By Friday, June 24th, 2016**

- ※ After providing the announcement of all successful applicants must submit additional documents if it is not admission standards will be not completed.
- ※ The additional applicants must submit all the documents needed by the application submission date.
  1. All admitted applicants
    - Certificate of Balance showing KRW 18,000,000(USD18,000) or more.
  2. Applicants who have applied throught Online or who have not submitted the original copy
    - Original copy of certified report for academic ability, degree and grade
    - Original copy of transcript for language ability (Failure to submit will prevent students from receiving scholarship)

**\* Application Reminder**

1. Write down the exact name of the department applied for in Korean or English.
2. Changing of majors is not allowed once the application has been accepted.
3. All documents must be in Korean or English. All other documents in another language must have a Korean or English translation.
4. All applications must contain all the necessary documents and are to be completed before the deadline. Only the application that met the deadline is acceptable when you apply via mail.
5. Applications sent by post with incomplete documents will be returned after deducting KRW 20,000 (USD 20).
6. All the submitted documents and application fee will not be returned.
- ※ The Household Register, Certificate of Graduation, Official Transcript and bankbook from Chinese applicants will be returned after all entrance procedures are completed.
7. All documents are not to be stapled.
8. All documents must be in size A4 format, if not it should be pasted on an A4 sized paper.
9. The applicant who has graduated high school or college 2 years ago or more must submit an objective document(attached with Korean translation) which indicates the applicant's goals or plans after graduation and the motivation to study.

**\* Acknowledgement of elementary, middle and high school completion standard**

1. Those who have completed elementary, middle and high school education for 12 years and above in a school overseas.
  - Acknowledgement of those who have completed elementary and middle school courses in one country overseas
  - Cases of those who have completed elementary and middle school education in more than two countries.

2. Others

- Those with overlapping school year (or semester) count, the overlapped completion courses will not be acknowledged.
- Overseas qualification examination, homeschooling, cyber education will also not be acknowledged.

## 8 Admission Criteria

A. Admission Criteria : **Document Screening and Interview**

B. Procedure

1. **Document screening**: International Cooperation Office examines whether or not the applications contain all necessary documents specified on the guideline.
2. **Interview**: Each department conducts the interview (Overseas residents may have a phone-interview after receiving a notification by the appropriate department)

※ The interview can be done only by the applicants who passed the screening documents process

### E. Important Notes

1. The number of admission may be limited within the capacity of each department.
2. Additional tests may be conducted by the department if necessary.
3. By rule, on-campus interview is mandatory; however, a phone interview can be conducted for applicants living abroad.
4. If it is found that the applicant has conducted the interview by a substitute, the admission will be canceled even though the semester has already started.
5. Interview location and date will be announced on the website
6. An applicant who is not eligible for application will still not be admitted regardless of his scores.
7. Other aspects regarding admission are based on the policy of the Committee of Admission for International Students.

## Reminders

- Admitted students who are expected to graduate from High School must submit their graduation certificate (or expected certificate of graduation) before the beginning of the semester, otherwise admission will be cancelled.
- If any of the application documents contain false information or forgery, admission will be cancelled immediately.
- If it is found that an applicant is admitted by illegal means or the applicant's graduation is unapproved by CBNU, admission will be cancelled, even if the applicant is already attending the university. Tuition fee is non-refundable.
- CBNU is not responsible for admission cancellation due to the mistakes made on the application, missing documents, and unfulfilled entry procedures.
- All the information including admission announcements will be posted on the homepage. Please follow the directions carefully.
- All accepted applicants must complete all admission and registration procedures before the deadline. If the tuition fee is not paid on the deadline, admission will be cancelled.
- Regulations of Chonbuk National University are applied to the items that are not defined on this prospectus and other particulars are decided by the Committee of Admission Screening for International Students.
- Admitted students must submit their International Student Insurance Policy by 1/4 of the semester period. Failure to submit the Proof of International Student Insurance Policy will prevent scholarship candidates from receiving scholarships the following semester
  - If applying for International Student Accidental Insurance, the maximum indemnification amount must be at least 10,000 dollars for overseas insurance policies and 10 million won for domestic insurance policies with regards to injury or hospitalization.
