2 Colleges & Departments

1. Admission :

– All freshman students will be enrolled to Global Frontier College for one-year and take Korean language classes and elective courses. After the first year, students will choose their major.

– Students must fill out three preferred majors they want to study on the application form. (College of Arts and English Track applicants do not have to write all three.)

– Students will be temporarily placed to departments based on their interview scores. Based on their temporary departments, students will learn either international humanity studies or international natural sciences.

※ Temporary departments are not permanent. Students will be placed to their permanent departments after the end of the first year. Interviews, students' preferred majors, test scores will be considered during placement. Students can change their planned majors during their first year or at the end of the year through following due procedures.

※ Students who applied to college of arts will be placed to their majors upon entering.

※ English Track applicants will be placed to engineering science department and Jimmy Carter School of International Studies.

※ There's no limit for the number of applicants. However, each department will go through internal evaluation on capability to accept international students.

- 1) All courses at Jimmy Carter School of International Studies are in English.
- 2) Students cannot transfer to department of Bio Science & Rural Resources (freshman only).

3 Eligibility and Requirements

A. Citizenship/Academic Requirements

1) **Freshman (first year) student** : Applicant must meet one of the following requirements

- A) Applicants and his/her parents must be foreign nationals, must not possess Korean citizenship and must have completed or expected to complete regular curriculums at accredited primary and secondary educational institutions in Korea or overseas (Dual citizenship holders cannot to apply) (Students who have passed Qualification for High School Graduation are eligible to apply)

B) Applicant who have foreign passports and have completed curriculums in overseas that are equivalent to primary and secondary education in Korea.

2) Transfer Student : Applicant must meet a) and b) [or] a) and c)

A) Applicants and his/her parents must be foreign nationals and must not possess Korean citizenship [or] Applicants must be foreign nationals and must have completed regular primary and secondary education overseas

B) Applicants must have completed or be expected to complete at least 2 years of a 4-year undergraduate degree program— with acquisition of 65 credits(35 credits if applicants want to apply as sophomore) for graduation— at an accredited university inside or outside Korea

c) Applicants must have graduated or be expected to graduate from a 2- to 3-year associate degree program at an accredited college inside or outside of Korea with acquisition of 65 credits

※ Expected graduates from junior college can apply

※ Graduates from non-accredited university cannot apply

※ Applicants can apply regardless of majors from their previous university, and recognition for course credits will be up to the dean's decision from each department

※ Applicants who were expelled from school for disciplinary actions and students currently enrolled to CBNU, including CBNU students on gap years cannot apply

B. Language Proficiency Requirements : Applicants who meet one of the following requirements

1) General (International Natural Science, International Humanity Studies, College of Arts and transfer students)

A) Applicant with Test of Proficiency in Korean **TOPIK Level 3** or above.

B) Applicant who has completed **Korean Class Level 4** at the Korean Language Education Center in Korea.

C) Applicant for the College of Arts(except for Industrial Design) may apply without the above mentioned language proficiency if they can take classes that are delivered in Korean.

※ Notes about Korean Language Proficiency

- ▶ The certificate must within the expiration date for its validity.
- ▶ If applicants do not have appropriate test score when they apply, they can submit a TOPIK test identification slip or a Certificate of Enrollment for Korean Language Education Center. After that, the applicants must submit the document for Korean Language Proficiency by Feb 14, 2018(Wed). Applicants failing to meet the deadline will not be accepted.
- ▶ Limitation for Class Registration based on TOPIK Level
 - TOPIK Level 3 and below : students can take up to 12 credits
 - TOPIK Level 4 and above : students can take up maximum credits
- ▶ Upon enrollment, all admitted students must acquire TOPIK Level 4 and above to meet graduation requirement

2) English Track Applicants (Jimmy Carter School of International Studies and Engineering Science majors)

- A) International Natural Science majors: Applicants must have one of the following Official English scores – TEPS 600, IELTS 5.5, iBT TOEFL 71 (CBT 197, PBT 530)
- B) International Humanity Studies Jimmy Carter School of International Studies: Applicants must have one of the following Official English scores – TEPS 600, IELTS 5.5, iBT TOEFL 80
- C) For all applicants to English Track: Applicants from English speaking countries can substitute official English test scores with their certificates of middle and high school graduation
 - ※ English speaking countries include the USA, the UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Republic of South Africa, Ireland, the Philippines and India

4 Application Procedure

A. How to Apply

- 1) Online Application : Submit application form on UWAYAPPLY(<http://www.uwayapply.com>)
- 2) Mail Application : Print and submit a completed set of required documents to the designated address of Chonbuk National University before the application deadline
 - ※ After the online application deadline, the modification of application detail as well as cancellation of application are not permitted

B. Admission Criteria : Document Screening and Interview

- 1) Document screening : Office of International Cooperation will examine whether applicants have submitted all necessary documents and have appropriate language proficiency
- 2) Interview: Each department will conduct interview (Students living abroad will be interviewed on the phone)

1) Certificate of Diploma Verification (one of the following documents)

- A) Apostille Convention Countries : Documents for submission— graduation certificate(Degree certificate) apostille, issued by government appointed organizations.
- B) Countries outside the Apostille Convention : Certificate of academic background approved by Korean embassy [or] applicant's country's embassy in Korea. Documents can be issued by Korean consulate or the applicant's country's embassy in Korea.
- C) CHINA : Documents for submission— 1 copy of Academic/Degree certificate from the Ministry of Education or Degree Confirmation Center. Documents can be issued by the following organizations
Ministry of Education's Academic Certification Center—www.chsi.com.cn,
Ministry of Education's Certification Center—www.cdgdgc.edu.cn

6 Note for Applicants

A. Important Notes for Submission

- 1) Write down the exact name of the department you applied for in Korean or English and changing your department is not allowed once the application has been accepted.
- 2) All required documents must be original documents. If originals cannot be submitted, copies can be submitted only if they have been confirmed as true copies of the original by relevant organizations/institutions or the Office of International Cooperation at Chonbuk National University upon submission.
- 3) **All documents must be in Korean or English. Any documents written in languages other than those two languages must be translated into Korean or English.**
- 4) All applications must contain all required documents and are to be completed before the deadline. Only the application that met the deadline is acceptable when you apply via mail.
- 5) CBNU is not responsible for admission cancellation due to the mistakes made on the application, missing documents, and unfulfilled entry procedures.
- 6) If any of application documents contain false information or forgery, admission will be cancelled immediately. Also, if an applicant is found to be not fully eligible for the requirement, admission may also be rescinded even after the admission has been granted. In this case, tuition fee

is non-refundable. Furthermore, they cannot apply for Chonbuk National University for next 3 years.

- 7) Admitted applicant who is an expected graduate or still attending school/university/college at the time of the application submission must submit a Certificate of Completion or Diploma to the OIC, CBNU by Jun 20, 2017(TUE), otherwise their admission may be withdrawn.
- 8) All documents are not to be stapled.
- 9) All documents must be in size A4 format, if not it should be pasted on an A4 sized paper.

B. Important Notes for All Applicants

- 1) Applicant must always follow instructions from the 'Notice Board(학사공지)' on the CBNU website.
- 2) Applicant can choose to apply either for the 1st or 2nd round of the Fall semester 2017 intake. However, applicant who has been admitted to CBNU in the 1st round cannot apply for the 2nd round. Applicant who failed in the 1st round can apply for the 2nd round but the applicant will have to repeat the same application process and submit the supporting documents again.
- 3) A non-Korean citizen applicant with Korean citizen parents can apply to CBNU up to six times per year regardless of the type or rounds of screening you one applied for. Any applicant who has violated this will be disadvantaged and have one's application withdrawn by the university.
- 4) Following applicant may be **Denied or Disqualified for Admission**.
 - A) Applicant who fail to pay their tuition fee before the designated deadline.
 - B) Applicant who is enrolled in two or more universities on the same semester.
- 5) Evaluation scores for admission will not be disclosed.
- 6) All the information including admission announcements will be posted on the homepage so applicant must follow the directions carefully.
- 7) **The most accurate and frequently used contact telephone number and email address must be provided** so that applicant can be reached immediately in case of emergency. CBNU is not responsible for not being able to reach the applicant because of the wrong contact details provided by the applicant in the application form. (**Yahoo, Hotmail, Sina E-mail servers are unavailable**)
- 8) All the submitted documents and application fee will not be returned or refunded.
 - ※ The original Certificate of Graduation and the Household Register(Hukoubu) from Chinese applicants will be returned after all entrance procedures are completed.

- 9) After submitting application, the examinee' s number will be issued. With the examinee' s number, students can check the schedule for interview, announcements and pay tuition fees.
- 10) Regulations of CBNU are applied to the items that are not defined on this prospectus and other particulars are decided by the Committee of Admission Screening for International Students.

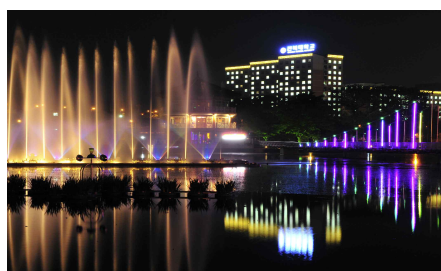
C. Application : Must be applied at the time of application for admission

- 1) All international students can reside at the dormitory. Dormitory application will be cancelled automatically if applicant do not make payments for the dormitory fee by the deadline.
- 2) If students want to withdraw their dormitory application, they have to inform to either the Office of International Cooperation or the Office of the Dormitory by FEB 26, 2018(MON).
