## **Admission Guidelines**

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#### Important Notes for Submission

- 1. There are two deadlines for submission. The first will be on Oct 26<sup>th</sup> 18:00. And second deadline will be on Nov 30<sup>th</sup> 18:00. Please note that your submission will be completed when you have filled out all required fields and make your payment for the application.
- 2. Write down the exact name of the department you applied for in Korean or English. You cannot change the department you applied or receive refund for application fee once you completed your submission.
- 3. All documents must be in Korean or English. Any documents written in languages other than those two languages must be translated into Korean or English.
- 4. Please print out the test ID slip. The test ID slip is required for checking your interview schedule, exam/interview results and tuition fee payment.
- 5. Even if you have finished online registration, you will be excluded from document screening if you don't submit necessary documents within the deadline.
- 6. CBNU is not responsible for any disadvantages resulting from writing down invalid contact point or being out of contact.
- 7. CBNU will only accept official language exam certificates that was issued within the last two years.

#### Important Notes for All Applicants

- 1. All required documents must be original documents. If originals cannot be submitted, copies can be submitted only if they have been confirmed as true copies of the original by relevant organizations/institutions or the Office of International Cooperation at Chonbuk National University upon submission.
- 2. All the submitted documents and application fee will not be returned or refunded after finishing application period, and changing your department is not allowed once the application has been accepted. (The original Certificate of Graduation will be returned after all entrance procedures are completed.)
- 3. All the information including admission announcements will be posted on the homepage so applicant must follow the directions carefully.
- 4. CBNU is not responsible for any disadvantages resulting from not submitting necessary documents submitting invalid contact points, not following application process, not confirming the final application results, being out of contact and etc.
- 5. Evaluation scores for admission will not be disclosed.
- 6. If any of application documents contain false information or forgery, admission will be cancelled immediately. Also, if an applicant is found to be not fully eligible for the requirement, admission may also be rescinded even after the admission has been granted. In this case, tuition fee is non-refundable. Furthermore, they cannot apply for CBNU for next 3 years.
- 7. Applicant who is enrolled in two or more universities on the same semester or fail to pay their tuition fee before the designated deadline may be Denied or Disqualified for Admission
- 8. Admitted applicant who is an expected graduate or still attending school/university/college at the time of the application submission must submit a Certificate of Completion or Diploma to the OIC, CBNU by Feb 25<sup>th</sup>(Mon), 2019, otherwise their admission may be withdrawn.
- 9. Regulations of CBNU are applied to the items that are not defined on this prospectus and other particulars are decided by the Committee of Admission Screening for International Students.
- 10. Final successful candidates must read through 'Notes', and must apply for their visa, dormitory, insurance and sign up for lectures within the given period. Also, they must pay the tuition fee during the given period
- \* This admission guideline is originally written in Korean and translated into English and Chinese. Should there be any discrepancies, Korean version dominates translated versions.

## **Eligibility and Requirements**

#### A. Citizenship/Academic Requirements

- 1) Freshman (first year) student: Applicant must meet one of the following requirements
  - A) Foreign nationals: Applicants whose parents AND themselves are of foreign nationals who have finished or expected to finish their primary and secondary education in overseas. Foreigners who have passed Qualification for High School Graduation are also eligible to apply. Applicants must not hold Korean citizenship or dual citizenships.
  - B) Applicant who holds foreign passports and have completed education in overseas that are equivalent to 12 years of primary and secondary education in South Korea.
- 2) Transfer Student : Applicant must meet a) [or] b)
  - A) Applicants AND their parents must be of foreign national, completed their primary and secondary education in South Korea or from overseas. Applicants must have completed 4 semesters (2 academic years) and acquired at least 65 credits from 4 year university. (Applicants transferring as sophomore must acquire at least 35 credits)
  - B) Applicants who have completed their primary and secondary education from overseas and completed 4 semesters (2 academic years) and acquired at least 65 credits from 4 year university. (Applicants transferring as sophomore must acquire at least 35 credits)
    - \* Applicants must have graduated or to be graduates from 2- to 3-year associate degree programs at an accredited college in South Korea or from overseas with acquisition of 35(sophomore) credits / 65(junior) credits
    - \* Expected graduates from junior (community) college can apply
    - Graduates from non-accredited university cannot apply
    - \* Applicants who have graduated from 5 year degree programs (high school+college) must submit their high school diploma and college diploma and transcripts respectively.
    - \* Applicants can apply regardless of majors from their previous university, and recognition for course credits will be up to the dean's decision from each department
    - \* Applicants who were expelled from school for disciplinary actions and students currently enrolled to CBNU, and CBNU students on gap years cannot apply
    - \* Transcripts must include earned credits and grades in percentile system.

- B. Language Proficiency Requirements: Applicants must meet one of the following requirements
  - 1) General (International Natural Science, International Humanity Studies, College of Arts and transfer students)
    - A) Test of Proficiency in Korean TOPIK Level 3 or above.
    - B) Applicants who have completed **Korean Class Level 4** at the Korean Language Education Center in Korea.
    - C) Applicants to College of Arts(except for Industrial Design) may apply without the above mentioned language proficiency if they can take classes in Korean.
  - 2) English Track (Jimmy Carter School of International Studies and Engineering Science)
    - A) Engineering Science: Applicants must have one of the following Official English exam scores TEPS 600(New TEPS 330), IELTS 5.5, iBT TOEFL 71 (CBT 197, PBT 530)
    - B) Jimmy Carter School of International Studies: Applicants must have one of the following Official English exam scores TEPS 600(New TEPS 330), IELTS 5.5, iBT TOEFL 80
    - C) For all applicants to English Track: Applicants from <u>English speaking countries</u> can substitute official English exam scores with their secondary school diploma.
      - \* English speaking countries include the USA, the UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Republic of South Africa, Ireland, the Philippines, India and etc.

## Application Procedure / Paying application fee

### A. How to Apply

- 1) Online Application: Submit application form on JINHAKAPPLY(http://www.jinhakapply.com)
- 2) Mail Application: Print and submit a completed set of required documents to CBNU before the application deadline
  - \* After the online application deadline, applicants cannot modify or cancel their application

#### B. Admission Criteria: Document Screening and Interview

- 1) Document screening: Office of International Cooperation will examine whether applicants have submitted all necessary documents and have appropriate language proficiency
- 2) Interview: Each department will conduct interview (Students from abroad will be interviewed on the phone or video) \*\*College of Arts applicants may undergo performance tests.

- C. Certificate of Admission: It will be issued to the final successful applicants who have submitted all the documents
- D. Student VISA(D-2) issue and changes: Students can apply for visa at Office of International Cooperation(OIC) or their embassy from abroad
  - 1) Students in Korea: Prepare the required documents and visit OIC after paying the tuition
- 2) Overseas resident: OIC will send 'Certificate of Business registration' and 'Certificate of Admission' to the successful candidates  $\Rightarrow$  Visit Korean embassy in your country with required documents\*  $\Rightarrow$  After arriving in Korea, apply Alien Card issue at OIC, CBNU \*You can check through the Korean Embassy website in your country.
- \* Successful candidates are responsible to acquire their visa. It is sole responsibility of the students if their visas are refused or delayed. If those students cannot enter Republic of Korea, they can apply for full tuition refund by submitting entrance disclaimer letter by Feb 28<sup>th</sup>

  - 1) All international students can reside at the dormitory. Dormitory application will be cancelled automatically if applicant do not make payments for the dormitory fee by the deadline
- 2) If students want to cancel their dormitory application, they have to inform to either Office of International Cooperation or Office of Dormitory by Feb 15<sup>th</sup>. Penalty may be charged if you cancel the application after Feb 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 3) Before entering the dorm, students should submit tuberculosis check up document by Feb 25<sup>th</sup>. Those who had submitted their TB document to the embassy must send scanned copy to the admissionu@ibnu.ac.kr
