The English and IELTS Training Programme

This course is aimed at university students; the course provides English Language tuition and gives an insight into topics of general interest and the UK's higher education system.

The programme aims to improve students' English levels, provide an introduction to academic English, and will also provide IELTS training in a closed class. A course co-ordinator will oversee their programme and liaise with a nominated counterpart from Jeonbuk National University as required.

In addition to the English lessons, students will also benefit from a social programme, which may include activities, such as a film night, trip to London, sports, etc.

Course Level:	Students need to have a level equivalent to IELTS 4.0 or more in each component. Students who do not have a recognised English qualification can sit our placement test.
Course Dates:	September 25 th to 13 th December, 2024
Hours per Week:	19 hours
Maximum Class Size:	14
Payment:	All fees will be paid at least 1 month before the course begins.
Tuition fees:	£4,930 per student (minimum of 15 students). Fees include tuition, lesson materials, and activities & excursions.
Accommodation:	Homestay includes airport pick up, airport drop off: FB (with breakfast, packed lunch, evening meal) HB (with breakfast, evening meal) On-campus food is readily available.

On-campus:	Self-catering, on-campus accommodation may be available at a cost of £2,870. The maximum number of students on campus is 50.
Meet & Greet:	Participants will be met at London Heathrow Airport and brought to their accommodation by private transport. At the end of the course, participants will be taken back to London Heathrow Airport by private transport.
Qualifications:	Successful completion of this course can be considered for Credit Transfer to Jeonbuk National University, the value being 15 Credits. Jeonbuk National University will receive a report on each student that is signed by the Director of Brunel Language Centre.

Orientation:

Students should arrive on Tuesday 24th September when they will be greeted at the airport. Wednesday 25th to Saturday 28th will consist of orientation, placement testing, introductory lessons, campus and local tour and visit to London. Students will be taken on a sight-seeing tour and see such sights as Buckingham Palace, Big Ben, Trafalgar Square, the Changing of the Guards and a London museum.

Other Activities

Students will enjoy at least 2 other day trips and visit places, such as Windsor, Bath, Brighton, Oxford, Cambridge, etc; and also be able to enjoy activities, such as Film Club, Book Club, Badminton, Museums, Theatre, etc. Students can also apply for a Brunel buddy. Because there is a limit to the number of Brunel students available for the buddy system, we will not be able to guarantee that every student can have a buddy. However, all students will have opportunities to meet Brunel students and other international students outside of class in a variety of social activities.

Facilities, Accommodation and Student Support

Students will be greeted at Heathrow airport and brought to their accommodation by private transport. They will be taken back to the Heathrow airport at the end of the course.

Everything at Brunel is on one site, including: hotel and spa, student accommodation, Brunel Language Centre, cafeteria, canteen, restaurant, take-aways, bars, shops, sports facilities, library, lecture theatres, support services, medical centre and more. Brunel campus is a very secure environment: we have CCTV and our own 24/7 uniformed security team led by a police officer.

Students' welfare is paramount and will be overseen by Brunel Language Centre. Students will benefit from small class sizes, a weekly tutorial and additional Brunel Language Centre pastoral care as required. In addition, they can take advantage of the University's dedicated central student support services, including advice services and counselling.

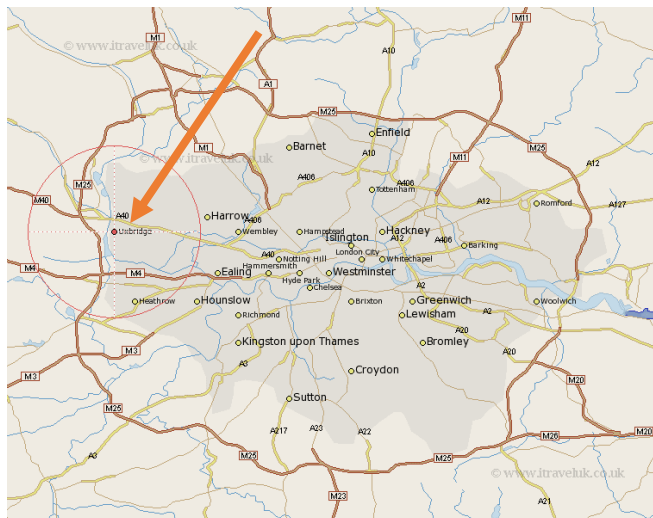
Brunel Campus
