The participants are responsible for the insurance costs. The insurance must cover: health insurance, general liability insurance for third party and personal accident coverage.

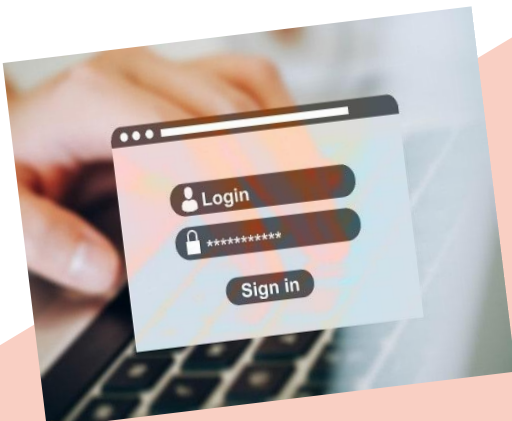
