When applying, students receive a fee waiver code.



Documents to provide (in jpg or pdf format):

- ✓ A digital picture (passport size)
- ✓ Curriculum Vitae
- ✓ Statement of purpose
- ✓ Transcripts of records (In French or English)
- ✓ English Test results (TOEIC, IELTS...)*
- ✓ Passport copies (main pages) or ID card for EU students
- ✓ International health insurance --> optional



2. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT*

- **TOEFL** (minimum score 550 ITP, 80 IBT)
- **TOEIC** (minimum score 750)
- **IELTS** (minimum score 6.0)
- Cambridge ESOL Examinations BULATS (B2)
- English teacher proficiency letter (B2 level minimum)



3. LIVING EXPENSES (ESTIMATION)

	TOTAL LIVING COSTS	Approximately 1200€ – 1500€ per month

4. EPITA HOUSING
