## ■ Admission Timeline

## ■ Nationality and Educational background

- \* Applicants' major should be one of those fields of **Engineering, Natural Science, and Agricultural** department.
- \* Those who are recommended by the president of applicants' graduating university

## ① Condition 1

- Applicant and both of applicant's parents must be foreigners.
- Must hold a Bachelor's degree [Master's degree applicants] or Master's degree [Doctoral degree applicants] after completing college curriculum legally. (Including applicants who anticipate a Bachelor's or Master's degree prior to the starting semester)

## ② Condition 2

- Must be a foreigner. (Nationality of the applicant's parents does not matter.)
- Must hold a Bachelor's degree [Master's degree applicants] or Master's degree [Doctoral degree applicants] after graduating from elementary, middle school, high school and college outside Korea. (Including applicants who anticipate a Bachelor's or Master's degree prior to the starting semester)

## ■ Language Proficiency

- Korean
  - Level 3 or higher on the TOPIK (Test of proficiency in Korean)
  - Completion of Level 3 or higher at the Korean Language Center of Chonbuk National University or other universities in Korea
- English
  - Minimum score required for standard exams (TOEFL: PBT 550, CBT 210, iBT 80, IELTS: 5.5, TEPS: 550)
  - Completion of secondary or higher education in countries where English is the native language. (Ex. U.S.A, Canada, England, Australia and Republic of South Africa)
  - Completion of secondary or higher education at the officially authorized institutions (Students must submit their education verification, sealed by the graduating institution's President or Dean)

## ■ Scholarship for International Students

\* Failure to submit the proof of Health Insurance will prevent scholarship candidates from receiving scholarship and applying for the dormitory the following semester

- **Whole Tuition Fee Waiver** : Approximately 5,000,000~6,000,000 won a year  
- (To continue the scholarship, students should keep more than GPA 3.63 of school record.)
- **Residence Hall Fee Waiver** : Approximately 3,500,000 won a year
- **Airfare** : Round economy class ticket  
\* It will be provided based on the country and its GDP. The fees for domestic travel within a scholar's home country and for travel insurance will not be provided.  
\* Note: Round-trip airfare is divided into two one-way tickets. One-way ticket will be provided for the trip from the student's home country to Korea. Return ticket to the student's home country will be provided upon graduation. Before purchasing their ticket, students must inform the International Affairs Office about the ticket fee.
