Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program as of July 21, 2017.
- 2. Must be 18 years old or above as of July 21, 2017.
- 3. Must be able to attend courses and give presentation in English, and submit an assignment paper after the program.
- 4. Must attend all of the program activities from July 21 August 2, 2017.

Program Fee

150,000 Yen (JPY)

- This includes tuition fee, transportation and field trip/workshop fee in the program, transportation and accommodation (one night) for the Nagano field trip and welcome/farewell parties.
- · Airfare to and from Japan and accommodation in Tokyo are not included.

Accommodation Fee (Optional)

- ® Single room (Hotel) 117,000 JPY (9,000 JPY/night)
- · Check-in date is July 20 and check-out date is August 3 (13 nights in total).
- The payment of the accommodation fee will be made directly to the travel agent, and not to Meiji University.

Evaluation

Participants will be graded on attendance and attitude, presentation and an assignment paper. A certificate and evaluation record will be given upon successful completion of the program. Students who require credits should inquire at their home universities.
