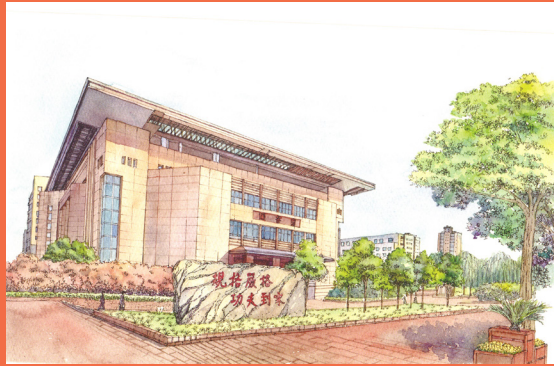

Please provide one of the following documents as reference:

IELTS: a score of 5.5 or above

TOEFL: a score of 80 or above

Other: English proficiency certificate from student home university.
