# 1 What is the AUEA student exchange program?

It is a program that students are dispatched to outstanding universities in Asia as a mutual exchange with a dedicated professor and complete related subjects and earn credits in English. And it is to develop students' language ability as well as international sense and global skills.

\* The selection and dispatch of dedicated professors may change in the future.

# 2 Purpose of the program

- To establish international exchange platforms with universities in Malaysia, Indonesia, and Singapore through this Asian University Education Association (AUEA)
- Developing an international perspective by learning advanced studies of outstanding universities
   in Asia
- Developing proactive human resources to communicate and collaborate based on diverse experiences and knowledge

# 3 Selection Overview

- Number of people selected: Around 70
- Dispatch period: 2nd semester of 2023 (September 2023 to February 2024)
- Dispatched countries: Malaysia, Indonesia
- $\circ$  Budget allocated: 1,300,000 won  $\times$  70 students = 91,000,000 won (expected up to 200 people)



- 2. Mail or On-site × Additional selection will be made according to local university circumstances and student application status

#### C. Selection criteria

- 1. Selected in the order of document screening result scores
- 2. In the case of ties, priority will be in the order of CGPA
- 3. Those who fail the orientation without prior consultation will be rejected

# 10 Scholarship

#### A. Scholarship Amount

- : 1,000,000~1,700,000won /1 semester
- B. Payment method: Transfer to the bank account submitted at the time of document submission

#### C. Payment Time

1 <sup>st</sup> Scholarship	3 weeks after departure report	70% of the full scholarship	The timing of payment

#### D. Scholarship Redemption

- : If any of the following criteria is not met, 100% of the scholarship will be redeemed
  - 1. A person with an attendance rate of less than 80%
  - 2. A person who has failed to pass the dispatch university curriculum (program)
  - 3. A person who does not maintain his/her status as a student during the dispatch period and does not pay tuition before 1/4 of school days to JBNU (100% of the scholarship is redeemed, and students should return)

# 11 Credit Transfer

#### A. How to

- Before dispatch : Consultation with your department
- After dispatch: on the basis of transcript/completion certificate issued by the dispatch university

#### B. Credits

X Credit recognition may be delayed depending on the timing of issuance of the transcript /completion certificate of the dispatched university

- \* If the attendance rate does not exceed 80% but meets the criteria for completion of the dispatched university, credits are recognized, but 100% of the scholarship is redeemed
- X Credits received overseas are recognized only as grades for the relevant semester, and do not affect the overall grade average
  - \* Apply for Postal Delivery of Transcript to OIA, JBNU

# 12 Others

A. Cancellation after the selection period may result in the following restrictions

- Negative points will be given when applying for Office for International Affairs program in the future
- If you cancel Office for International Affairs program more than three times without permission,
   you will not get support for the Office for International Affairs program in the future

#### B. No change in dispatch period applied at the time of selection (no extension or reduction)

- C. Cancellation is not possible after the selection and start of the program, but cancellation is possible in case of any of the following reasons: 100% of the scholarship subsidy is redeemed
  - If your health deteriorates and you can no longer pursue your study (doctor's note should be submitted)
- D. Visa issuance must be completed according to the academic schedule of the dispatched university
  - · For foreign students, it may be difficult to issue a visa, so please be noted on that.
