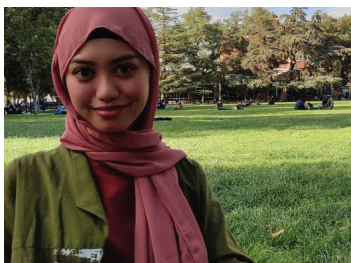

In recognition of this, the Global Study Program has partnered with the UC Davis Continuing and Professional Education Leadership Program to develop the International Leadership Development Seminar.

This seminar is specifically designed for international students who are interested in improving their leadership skills and learning more about American perspectives on leadership. The seminar will focus on leadership development and career services, and it will include networking opportunities, interactive activities and guest speakers.

During the 10-week seminar students will:

- Engage in community building with fellow international students
- Discuss leadership skills with peers
- Explore leadership tools and techniques common in the United States
- Practice leadership tools and techniques in a protected setting

This seminar is only open to UC Davis Global Study Program students, and participants who complete the seminar will earn a UC Davis Certificate and a badge for their LinkedIn profile. We are excited to be able to provide this new opportunity to our students and believe that it will enhance their international education experience and personal career opportunities.
