# CALL FOR APPLICATIONS(Extended)

International Centre for Water Security and Sustainable Management under the auspices of UNESCO (i-WSSM) is hosting a capacity building program for next generation leaders in water security from **20 – 24 February, 2023** at Daejeon and Daegu in the Republic of Korea.

This program will be a great opportunity for students studying or interested in water-related issues, to learn from Korea's leading researchers, and to gain practical knowledge through lectures, study visits, and more.

## **Objectives**

This capacity building program provides a comprehensive understanding of the advanced water management skills based on information and communication technologies (ICT) to respond to climate change. The students will have a great opportunity to enhance their awareness of the water security and be able to contribute to their home countries to achieve sustainable water and environment friendly policies.

## Program type & language

This course is a hybrid education program, consisting of an **online pre-course**\*and a **5-day face to face course** including lectures, and study visits. The entire program will be conducted in **English**.

\* The topics includes water security and nature-based solutions (NBS), the total length of one hour.

## Cost

The full amount of expense will be covered by the organizers.



- **Covered**: Transportation, accommodation, meals, program expenses, basic travel insurance
- **NOT covered**: compensation for damage and indemnification caused by participants, medical expense exceeding insurance coverage, other personal expenses

\* Transportation during the official program will be covered by the organizing institution, however, for individual train tickets, bus, etc. on **arrival (starts at Daejeon) and departure (completes in Daegu)** at the first and last day of the program should be arranged and covered individually.

## Eligibility

The program is designed for students who have an academic or professional backgrounds in the **water-related fields**.

To be eligible, participants must meet all the following criteria:

- ✓ Be international students currently enrolled in an academic program in Korea
- ✓ Hold a valid visa to be currently reside in the Republic of Korea
- ✓ Be the first time to join the program organized by i-WSSM
- ✓ Have fluency or working proficiency in English.

#### Additional points will be granted for applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Be a national of OECD DAC List of ODA Recipients
- Be government officials, staff members of partner or affiliated organizations, or relevant stakeholders working directly on issues regarding water
- Majoring in water-related fields such as water resource management, civil/ environmental/agricultural engineering, etc.
- Demonstrate a desire to engage the program with a clear vision and purpose

This program ensures the minimum women participation rate (30%) for balanced opportunity.



## Due dates (Extended)

The due date for submitting applications is 10am (KST), 6 February 2023.

## Certificate

Participants who successfully complete the course requirements will be awarded a certificate.

- Selected participants are required to complete an online pre-course prior to the program.
